Hard to believe, but we are less than a month away from the start of the "Solid Gold" 2019 GRCA National Specialty. It has definitely been a team effort with so many people pulling together to make this happen.

Help is still needed, from being part of the Field Trial, the WC/WCX, agility, working the raffle booth or the merchandise booth....help is needed. Email GRCGLA1@gmail.com if you can help one hour, two, or ?

If you work 4 hours at the Convention Center, you'll receive a food voucher and if you work eight hours, we have a nice windbreaker with the logo embroidered on it.

The Field Trial starts on Friday, October 18 and runs through the 20th at Prado Dog Training Park. We can use help with poppers and throwers during this event. Tracking is Sunday, October 20 at Southwestern College in Chula Vista.

Sunday at the convention center, grooming spaces will be marked. The electrician will follow the marking and pull the electricity for all the grooming spaces. We do not have access until Monday, October 21, at Event Hall A where conformation will occur. Similarly, the Ballrooms are not ours until Monday. We ask that no one enters either hall unless you are working. Tuesday starts obedience in the Ballrooms. The Crew will be setting up the obedience rings on Monday. Tables for vendors will be set on Monday as well as electricity pulled. Tuesday, the crew will set down the carpet for the conformation rings.

Agility meanwhile is about 1 1/2 miles away from the Convention Center and they will be active on Monday, October 21 and Tuesday, October 22. Sweepstakes followed by Conformation will begin Wednesday, October 23 and continue through Saturday, October 26, There is a CCA on Thursday, at the Convention Center and Sunday, at Prado Dog Training Park.

And while you're at the Convention Center, enjoy the music - as we will rock you with our Solid Gold Extravaganza!

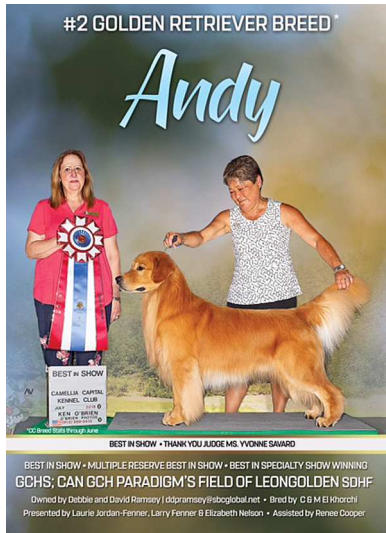
