Message From Our President



My story of dreams dimmed to only shine brighter in the end.

My sweet girl Nottie, who knows how to make me smile!

My pick of the litter, a standout at 5 weeks of age, started her show career at the GRCGLA Specialty in 2023, by winning Best of Breed 4-6 puppy.

She glided across the grass as smooth as silk without missing a step and loved every minute of it.

Shortly thereafter, my dreams were dimmed as Nottie started limping on one front leg, then followed by both front legs.

Both X-Rays and CT scans were done, along with several veterinarian consults, to find out that she had severe Bilateral Fragmented Coronoid Process (FCP).

Well, this was something very new to me and I had to research the possibilities of what kind of life my sweet girl would have.

Her recovery was uneventful, and she runs and plays with the best of them.

Fast forward to 18 months of age, Nottie has not come in to season as of yet. Ugh, now what is going on?

More time goes by, at 24 months of age she now looks like a spayed bitch. She is tall, over standard, long in body and head. She even appears to have a soft spay coat.

A vet visit was in order, blood work was done and was all completely normal including a thyroid and testosterone test to determine if she might be a hermaphrodite.

I joked about her being a hermaphrodite with friends and co-workers, saying, that would be my luck! Those test results were normal, phew!!

I still need to have her spayed, but I fear what they might find as she is now going on 3 years old this coming July, and still without a season.

Sometimes, things just go sideways, and we find ourselves having to take a different path. This new path we are on has been exciting and fun!

Now, let me get to the fun stuff that Nottie and I have been learning together.

In February 2024, I ventured back into the obedience ring for the first time in a very long time, entering Nottie in beginner novice for 2 days. She completed her BN title with a 2nd place.

Nottie had won her first Q last year, after she was attacked ringside by a golden retriever, go figure! So only 2 Q's were needed.

While at the same shows at Silver Bay, we entered a brand new sport to us: Rally Novice. Oh, what great fun Nottie had going around the ring with her wagging tail, (maybe mine too) and smiles on both our faces! Nottie Q'd on both days with scores of 97's with 4th and 2nd place wins.

On to April, and the Apple Valley KC for the next adventures in the ring. I entered us in Novice B, and Nottie scored a 191.5 and a 3rd place for her 2nd leg.

We also entered Rally Intermediate for the first time and that sweet, sweet girl of mine Q'd with a PERFECT score of 100 and 1st place! Yes, I had happy tears!

I have told my friend Vicki many times the signs are confusing and if we don't Q it would be my error, NOT Nottie's.

Well let me tell you, Nottie knew what she was doing but for me, I just followed her lead to perfection!
