You should be notified within 72 hours when a document is recorded on your property. The email alerts are for Foreclosure notice on your property, Transfer of Title, Grant Deed, Quitclaim Deed, Mortgage Deed, 2<sup>nd</sup> Trust Deed or etc.

The Email alert system will help you identify potential real estate fraud on their property.
